

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the adopted Public Participation Process that the Lawton Metropolitan Planning Organization will conduct a public hearing at 1:30 p.m. on the 16th day of September, 2010 in the Council Chambers, Wayne Gilley City Hall, 103 S. 4th Street, Lawton, Comanche County, Oklahoma, for the following purpose:

To adopt a Resolution amending the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Federal Fiscal Years 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2012. The FFY 2009-2012 TIP is amended to include an additional \$88,163 in Section 5307 funding for FFY 2010, an additional \$44,800 in Section 5309 funding for FFY 2010 and an additional local match of \$128,428 for the continued operation and management of the LATS fixed route and complementary paratransit service.

This public notice and the established review and comment period will satisfy the program-of-projects requirements of the Federal Transit Administration's Urbanized Area Formula Program. The TIP is a staged program encompassing a four-year period consisting of all federally funded transportation roadway, planning and transit improvements in the Lawton Metropolitan Transportation Study Area. The proposed amendment will increase the FFY 2010 Federal funding to \$2,494,347 and the Four-Year Summary of Federal funding to \$1,266,841,456.
