

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the adopted Public Participation Process that the Lawton Metropolitan Planning Organization will conduct a public hearing at 11:00 a.m. on the 5th day of September, 2023, in the Third Floor Conference Room, City Hall, 212 SW 9th Street, Lawton, Oklahoma, for the following purpose:

To adopt a Resolution approving the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Federal Fiscal Years 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027. The TIP is a staged program encompassing a four-year period consisting of all federally funded transportation roadway, planning, bicycle and pedestrian, and transit improvements in the Lawton Metropolitan Transportation Study Area.

This public notice and the established review and comment period will satisfy the program-of-projects requirements of the Federal Transit Administration's Urbanized Area Formula Program.
